Program Requirements

You have been ordered to participate in this program and/or voluntarily agreed to this program as a condition of bond or pre-trial release, as a condition of suspended sentence or probation.

The following requirements will apply to all participants in this program. While participating you will be subject to the following:

- ┆ **TESTING:** Participants are required to accomplish (.000%) two (2) preliminary breath tests daily, once in the morning and once in the evening.
- ┆ **LOCATIONS:** You have been ordered to participate in the 24/7 Program at the following location:

- ┆ **Hours:** 7 days/week, 365 days a year
Morning Tests: 8:00 a.m.-9:00 a.m.
Evening Tests: 8:00 p.m.-9:00 p.m.
- ┆ **Costs:** \$2.00 Dollars per PBT (Cash or Money Order Only)
You are required to pay in advance, or at the time of testing, for the PBT. Failure to pay will be considered a violation of your bond condition, and you may be arrested.
- ┆ **Missing a Test:** A No-Show during your designated testing hours is a violation of the 24/7 Sobriety Program. *If you miss a test, will be subject to immediate incarceration.*
- ┆ **Positive Test:** If the **PBT** indicates the presence of alcohol, you will be subject to immediate incarceration.

- ┆ Tests performed at another facility **DO NOT** count for this program. Unless prior arrangements have been made, tests at another facility will be considered violations. If you must leave the area, you must coordinate with your attorney/lay advocate or public defender and the 24/7 Program staff to make sure the facility has the appropriate paperwork at least one (1) week before you leave.
- ┆ Thirty (**30**) minutes prior to testing, you shall NOT use or consume any food, beverages, gum, toothpaste, and tobacco products. Do not put anything in your mouth during the **30 minutes** prior to testing. **This can be considered a violation of the 24/7 Program**
- ┆ Any improper use of alcohol products constitutes a violation of the 24/7 program. This includes, but is not limited to, mouthwash, cough syrup, and other commercial products containing alcohol (*including cold medicines such as Nyquil*).

In the event the Defendant appears at the time and place designated but violates any testing conditions, tampers with or destroys any testing equipment, or fails any 24/7 Sobriety Program test required by this bond, then the following consequences shall occur:

Twice Daily PBT Testing:

1st Violation: Immediate in-custody detention of the Defendant for a period of twelve (12) hours. After the twelve (12) hours, the defendant will be released from detention. Bond will not be revoked and no court appearance will occur.

2nd Violation: Immediate in-custody detention of the Defendant for a period of twenty-four (24) hours. After the twenty-four (24) hours, the defendant will be released from detention. Bond will not be revoked and no court appearance will occur.

3rd or Subsequent Violation: Immediate in-custody detention of the defendant for a period of no more than seventy-two (72) hours, weekends and holidays excluded. Bond will be revoked and an appearance before a tribal judge will be necessary to re-address bond.

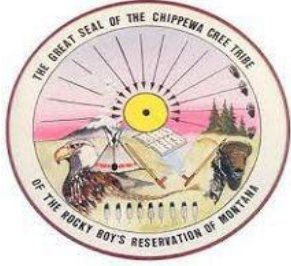

Release of Information

I, _____ (participant), have been ordered to participate in the 24/7 Sobriety Program. I understand that signing this Release of Information Form is a condition of the 24/7 Sobriety Program.

I authorize the disclosure and exchange of information relating to my participation in the 24/7 Sobriety Program among the agencies associated with the program. These agencies include the Chippewa Cree Tribe, Rocky Boy Health Board, White Sky Hope Center, Chippewa Cree Law Enforcement Services, Chippewa Cree Tribal Justice Center, state and local prosecuting agencies, and other criminal justice agencies.

In signing this Release of Information Form, I grant permission for these agencies to release, disclose, and exchange information including, but not limited to, enrollment, reporting, infractions or violations, and other information collected during my participation in the 24/7 Sobriety Program; information contained in my criminal records; and other information maintained by law enforcement agencies.

I understand that the information relating to my participation in the 24/7 Sobriety Program may be used by the above-listed agencies for authorized government and law enforcement activities. These activities include, but are not limited to, determining whether I used alcohol while in the 24/7 Sobriety Program; monitoring my compliance with the order placing me in the 24/7 Sobriety Program; and investigating whether I violated the 24/7 Sobriety Program's conditions and taking appropriate action. I also understand that the information may be used to evaluate the effectiveness of the 24/7 Sobriety Program.

I understand that my Release of Information remains in effect and cannot be revoked while I am a participant in the 24/7 Sobriety Program. This Release of

Information will expire when I complete the 24/7 Sobriety Program. I understand, however, that all information obtained during my participation in the program may be used for statistical purposes and may be disclosed and exchanged among the above-listed agencies if I am again placed in the 24/7 Sobriety Program.

I understand that I may be contacted for follow-up interviews to provide information for statistical purposes, which may include information related to my sobriety.

I understand that my removal from the 24/7 Sobriety Program for a violation does not constitute completion of the program.
